- 1) To determine the Overall Completion Percentage you will need to do the following:
 - Calculate Overall Attempted Hours by adding up all courses attempted in academic career including courses dropped with a "W".
 - Calculate Overall Earned Hours by adding up the credit hour value for each course in which you received a grade of "D" or better.

*Title IV aid eligibility does not allow exclusion of credit hours (attempted or earned) through Academic Bankruptcy. In other words, any credit hours excluded as a result of filing Academic Bankruptcy must be added to the overall attempted and earned credit hours.
