PURPOSE 14 As an institution of higher education, Louisiana State University at Eunice ("University" or "LSU 15 Eunice") is charged with maintaining systems and data for administrative and academic 16 purposes. These assets are critical to the mission of the University, and the acceptable use of 17 these systems and data sets must be managed with a formalized IT Risk Management Policy. 18 The purpose of this policy is to define the required Information Technology (IT) Risk 19 Management Processes and activities needed to effectively identify, analyze, report, and manage risks related to the University information systems and data. 20 II. DEFINITIONS 21 22 Risk Assessment. Risk assessment is the assessment of technology and business processes and identifying risks that could potentially impact the University's business. 23 24 Security Assessment. Security assessment is the testing or evaluation of security controls to determine the extent to which the controls are implemented correctly, operating as intended, 25 26 and producing the desired outcome with respect to meeting the security requirements for an 27 information system or organization. 28 III.
