3456789 10112 13 I. PURPOSE

- 14 As an institution of higher education, Louisiana State University at Eunice ("University" or "LSU 15 Eunice") is charged with maintaining systems and data for administrative, academic, and 16 research purposes. As the University is trusted with various data elements in relation to the 17 academic, research, and administrative business activities, it is also responsible for compliance 18 with various local, state, and federal regulations, as well as industry and/or contractual 19 requirements. These responsibilities must be managed through formalized compliance
- 20 programs.
- 21 The purpose of this policy is to outline requirements for that support compliance requirements at 22 LSU Eunice.

23 **II. DEFINITIONS**

- 24 Data. Any information residing on the University Information Technology (IT) Infrastructure or
- 25 held on any other IT Infrastructure on behalf of the University. This data includes files.
- 26 documents, messages in any format, including e-mail messages and posts made on any Social
- 27 Media site maintained by/for the University or its units. All data created and/or maintained by a
- 28 User is also subject to this Policy, even if the data is created and/or stored on the User's own
- 29 personal computer, smartphone, or other personal device.

30 **III. POLICY STATEMENT**

- 31 A. Contract Management
- 32 1. LSU Eunice shall establish vendor and contract management practices and 33 procedures that protect the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of the University 34 data, systems, and/or applications.
 - 2. LSU Eunice shall take reasonable steps to select and retain service providers that can maintain appropriate safeguards to protect the University data.
- 37 B. Compliance Program

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38 1. LSU Eunice shall implement and maintain compliance programs related to various compliance requirements, e.g., Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA), Family Education 39 40 Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), etc.

- 41 C. Login Banners Disclaimers and Consents
- LSU Eunice shall ensure that all authentication mechanisms used to access systems and/or applications must display login banners that outline or reference the authorized and legitimate use of the system, application, and/or network environment.
