12 13 14 15 16	All questions/changes in regard to possible substantive change or changes in program accreditation status (including voluntary withdraw from accreditation) shall be referred to the SACSCOC Accreditation Liaison for review.
17 18 19	The Liaison will then consult with the appropriate vice chancellor and the Chancellor to determine course of action, if any. All notifications to SACSCOC must be routed through the Office of the Chancellor; copies of which will be retained by the Accreditation Liaison.
