Malena Guevera – Appointed candidate for vacant Freshman Senator position

Malena introduced herself. Dr. Smith clarified that appointments to fill vacant positions are approved with a 2/3 majority vote.

Funding Request: \$1,500 for SGA President travel to Council of Student Body Presidents (COSBP) annual meeting in Washington, D.C. from January 25 to 29, 2023

Bettina Trumps introduced this funding request and gave some information about COSBP. COSBP is for student body presidents at colleges and universities, and it is organized by the Board of Regents. COSBP meets monthly and each meeting focuses on a specific issue/topic. For example, human trafficking and mental health were recent topics.

Non-officer in attendance asked questions about the purpose of the trip, and Bettina gave more information about her goals to represent the LSUE student body to our government leaders.

Joan Martinez called to a vote. Alexander Saunier seconded. 13 votes in favor. Zero opposed.

Funding Request: Additional \$1,000 for parade throws.

Bettina Trumps introduced the funding request, stating that the approved order for SGA branded beads 500 qty. will not be sufficient for all of the parades we want to participate in. Funding would go to branded items from 4imprint and generic beads to go with the SGA-logo beads.

Jose Sanchez called to a vote. Joan Martinez seconded. 13 votes in favor. Zero opposed.
