Call to Order.....Bettina Trumps, President

Meeting called to order by Bettina Trumps at 12:03 PM.

Finance Bill vs. Resolution

Process

Dr. Kyle Smith showed how to submit funding requests on lsue.edu on student government page

When submitting if we get a 51% vote on a bill, it will get approved.

Finance bill you can put things that do not include SGA.

Dr. Kyle asked if there's any additional questions. No additional questions were asked.

Funding Request: \$20,000 approved in April 2022 for funding for concrete & tent renovations to the soccer fields. More updated estimates reflect the following:

- Tents: \$5,900
- Concrete: \$23,366
- Total: \$29,266
- **Difference: \$9,266**

Initial request coach retired, and new request needs more things, so it is now 9,266 more dollars than the original 20,000 that was already taken out of our SGA account.

Called to vote by Bettina Trumps. Alexander Saunier seconded. 15 votes in favor. Zero opposed.

Funding Request: \$40 requested for Miss LSUE Decal for cars for parades

Bettina Trumps opened the floor to debate.

Alexander Saunier called to vote. Allie DuBroc seconded. 15 votes in favor. Zero opposed.

Funding Request: Trunk or Treat giveaway items (see 3 options)

Dr Kyle showed us decals we can give out. Option 1 is gummy candy, Option 2 is ghost poop, marshmallows, and option 3 is Hershey's kisses with our SGA stickers on the bottom.

Bettina Trumps opened the floor to debate.

Allie DuBroc, Kaylie Granger, and Joan Martinez agree Ghost poop is the best option since chocolate melts and there are some people allergic.

Allie Dubroc and Julia Bearb mentioned giving out stickers with SGA logo with the Ghost poop candy.

Option 2 was chosen, Ghost Poop, which will cost approx. \$200, and a motion was made to also purchase assorted candy and SGA stickers, budgeting an additional \$200 for a total of \$400.

Alexander Saunier called to a vote. Julia Bearb seconded.

15 votes in favor. Zero opposed.

Funding Request: \$755 for throws for upcoming parades

Called to vote by Zachary Thomas. Seconded by Jose Sanchez. 13 votes in favor. 2 votes opposed

Funding Request: \$600 for food/drink for the Eunice Political Forum reception
Veggie tray, sandwich tray, cookies, soda/water

Bettina Trumps opened floor to debate.

Called to vote by Joan Martinez. Seconded by Bettina Trumps. 15 votes in favor. 0 votes opposed.
