

LSU Eunice Essential Services Plan

LSUE is in process of ordering additional laptops and surface pros that can be used by faculty and staff to deliver instruction and services. Faculty are participating in training to move instruction to an online format and are working collaboratively to assist students, peers and departments as are staff in every department. All supervisors have met with staff to determine the efficacy of remote work assignments and have completed remote work contingency plans.

As a result, LSUE will be in a transition phase to shifting core operational functions to a virtual environment. We will follow the procedures established for social distancing, and will amend as needed. We understand the urgency and are working as quickly as possible.
