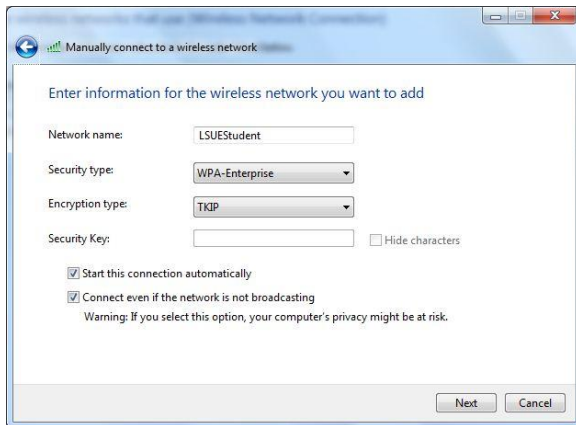
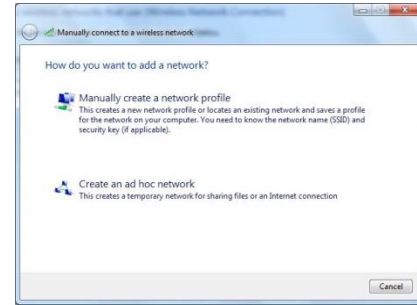
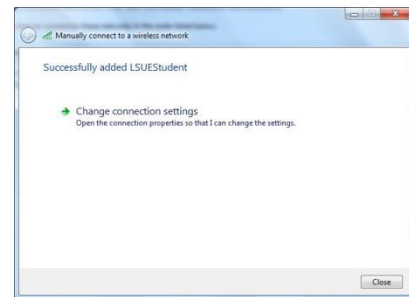


Windows 7 Wireless

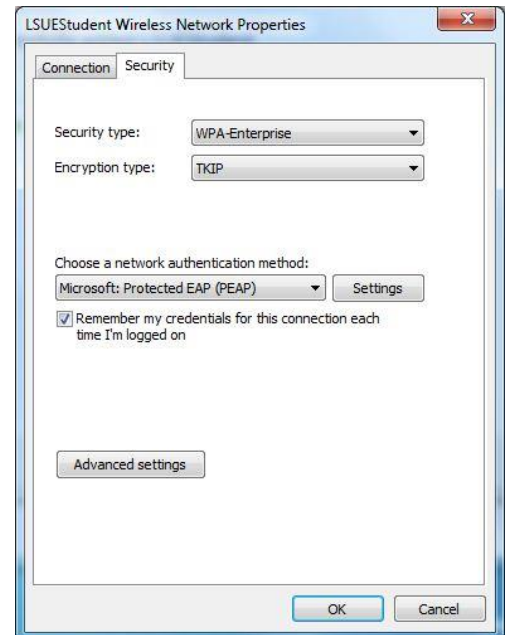
1. From the Start Menu, open Control Panel, Network & Internet, Network and Sharing Center.
2. Select Manage Wireless Networks from the left hand menu.
3. Click the Add button, select Manually create a network profile.
4. In the Network name field, type **LSUEStudent** (case sensitive) or **LSUEFacultyStaff** depending on your role with us.



5. Select **WPA-Enterprise** from the Security types dropdown list.
6. Select **TKIP** from the Encryption type dropdown list
7. Check the “Start this connection automatically” box and check the “Connect even if the network is not broadcasting”.
8. Click Next
9. Select **Change connection settings**.



10. On **Connection** tab, make sure both the “Connect automatically....” and “Connect even when not broadcasting...” boxes are checked.
11. On **Security** tab, select **Microsoft: Protected EAP (PEAP)** from the **Choose a network authentication method** dropdown list. Click the **Settings** button.

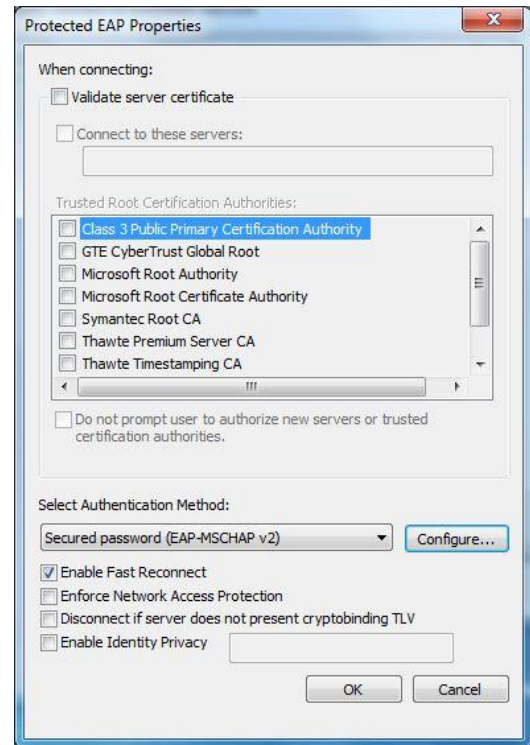
12. Uncheck the **Validate server certificate** box; select **Secured password (EAP-MSCHAP v2)** for authentication method; Click the **Configure** button.

13. Uncheck **Automatically use my Windows logon name and password**.

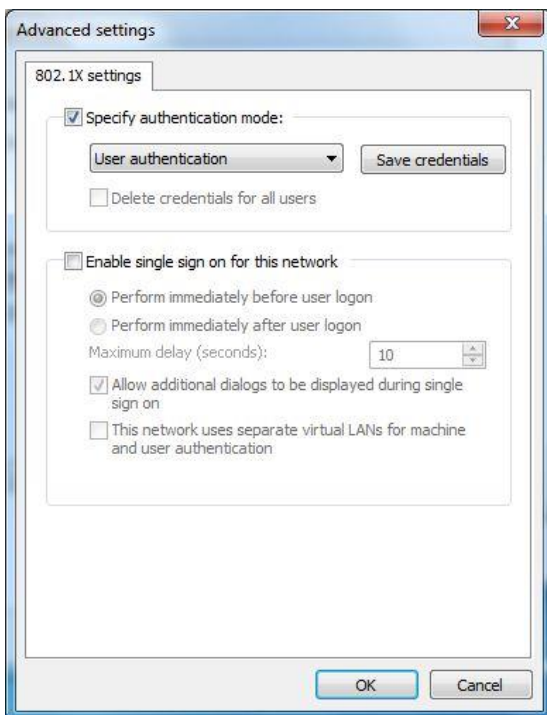
14. Click **OK** two times



15. Click the **Advanced settings** button (see last image on previous page).



16. Check **Specify authentication mode**; Select **User authentication** from the dropdown list; Click **Save Credentials**.



17. Enter your myLSUE (students) or network (faculty/staff) login information depending on your role at LSU Eunice. Click OK out of all windows.
