

Search - Step 3

- What you will see is not a list of databases by subject, but the companies that make those databases.
- Since Lexis-Nexis Academic is the only one we get by that company, it is listed.
- Click on the “LexisNexis Academic” link.
- If you are OFF campus, read Step 3B.

Search - Step 3B

Search – Step 5

- The sample topic we will be using for this search are smoking bans in restaurants.
- There are many ways of doing this search, but this show will only show a few.
- Type ‘smoking ban restaurant’ (without quotes) in the search box. Click “Enter”.
- Notice the default options – searching major US & World publications from the past 2 years. You may change them later.

Search – Step 6

- Here are the results.
- On the far left, you can see how many of those are a certain type – i.e., newspapers – as well as geography and language. We will look at using that option later.
- Notice the dates are out of order. The default is to search by relevance – how often your search terms are mentioned.
- Click on the “Sort” drop-down box.

Search – Step 7

- There are three ways to sort the results:
 - Publication Date – most recent first
 - Relevance – mentioned most often
 - Chronological – most recent last
- Publication Date tends to be the most useful, since one of the biggest factors about news sources are their dates.
- Choose “Publication Date” under “Sort”.

Search – Step 8

- Now the most recent articles are first.
- Notice the mix of international papers – that default choice of US & World papers.
- Also notice how recent that first paper is; only 2 days old. For databases, Lexis is very ‘fast’ in making material available.
- It is also a mostly full-text only database. (The exceptions tend to be law journals).
- Click on the title for #1 – “Smoking ban”.

Search – Step 9

- The header gives the name of the paper or other source, edition (such as Sunday or Local), and date. Often the country is given, especially for shorter or easily confused titles (like ‘Times’).
- The words we typed in are red.
- There is a printer icon off to the right (just past and under “Next Steps”).
- Go back to the list of results.

TASMANIA'S hotel industry says it has still not recovered from the hammering it took when indoor smoking laws came into effect 2 1/2 years ago. While their counterparts in New South Wales this week reported an 11 per cent, or \$385 million, loss in income since **smoking bans** were introduced, Tasmania's pubs and clubs recorded losses up to three times as high when the law changed here in January 2006.

CHA Tasmanian general manager Steve Old said Tasmania's gaming, **restaurant** and bar industry recorded a 20 to 30 per cent income loss in the months rattled out inside.

Tasmania's outer suburban hotels and country pubs were worst hit with one hotel reporting losses of more than 40 per cent in the first six months. "We have bounced back a bit, but we still have not clawed our way back to the level we were pre-**smoking bans**," Mr Old said yesterday.

There is a myth that pubs and clubs are run by big business which can take a bit of financial pain. But there are a lot of mum and dad operators

- Now let's look at those options on the left.
- The “Sources by Category” is expanded, so we can see all of the types under it.
- The rest are not.
- For example, click on “Geography”.

Search – Step 11

- We now have a list.
- Notice how it, like the other list, is given by number, rather than alphabetically or from bigger area (country) to smaller (city).
- Also note that Geography doesn't mean where the paper is from, but where the story or article takes place.
- Click on “United States”.

Search – Step 12

- As the number said, there are 175 articles that take place in the United States.
- Notice that the second article, the *Toronto Star*, is a Canadian paper.
- Also notice that I no longer see any places that have more articles than the United States (United Kingdom had 323).
- Now let's try a more specific type of search. Click on the "Sources" tab.


