**SACSCOC ACCREDITATION LIAISON’S RESPONSIBILITY TO REPORT
SUBSTANTIVE CHANGE AND ACCREDITING DECISIONS OF OTHER
AGENCIES**

I. PURPOSE

To establish a policy/procedure regarding the reporting of substantive change and accrediting decisions of other agencies.

II. GENERAL POLICY

It shall be the policy of LSU Eunice to report any substantive change or change in program accreditation status by the United States Department of Education to the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) in accordance with Commission Policy on [“Substantive Change for SACSCOC Accredited Institutions”](#) and [Accrediting Decisions of Other Agencies](#) as revised.

III. PROCEDURES

All questions/changes relating to possible substantive change or changes in program accreditation status (including voluntary withdraw from accreditation) shall be referred to the SACSCOC Accreditation Liaison for review.

The Accreditation Liaison will consult with the appropriate vice chancellor and the Chancellor to determine course of action, if any. All notifications to SACSCOC must be routed through the Office of the Chancellor; copies of which are retained by the Accreditation Liaison.
