16 17	To establish a policy/procedure regarding the reporting of substantive change and accrediting decisions of other agencies.
18	II. GENERAL POLICY
19 20 21 22 23	It shall be the policy of LSU Eunice to report any substantive change or change in program accreditation status by the United States Department of Education to the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) in accordance with Commission Policy on "Substantive Change for SACSCOC Accredited Institutions" and Accrediting Decisions of Other Agencies as revised.
24	III. PROCEDURES
25 26 27	All questions/changes relating to possible substantive change or changes in program accreditation status (including voluntary withdraw from accreditation) shall be referred to the SACSCOC Accreditation Liaison for review.
28 29 30	The Accreditation Liaison will consult with the appropriate LSU Eunice Vice Chancellors and the Chancellor to determine course of action, if any. All notifications to SACSCOC must be routed through the Office of the Chancellor; copies of which are retained by the Accreditation Liaison.
