New Business:

Funding Request: \$125 for Alpha Delta Nu Nursing Honor Society – 15 honors graduation cords \$6.25 each. Only for members of the honor society to wear at graduation.

Proposed Constitution Change

- Addition of the requirement of 2 office hours per week in the SGA Office

Bettina Trumps introduced a change to the constitution. Replacing the requirement for Senators to complete 2 outreaches to participating in two events per semester.
