- I understand that I will be contacted via my LSUE email for any issues with my VA Education benefits.
- _____ I understand that it may take the VA several weeks to process my paperwork in order to receive payment.
- I understand that I am responsible for paying my tuition and fees for attending LSU Eunice should VA deny my benefits for any reason.
- I understand that only courses listed as part of my degree or certificate can be certified for VA benefits. This can include developmental courses (if needed), prerequisites, and course substitutions (if approved).
- I understand that developmental courses taught via distance learning <u>cannot</u> be certified for VA benefits.
- I understand that dropping a class can cause a debt to the Department of Veterans Affairs. Any changes in my schedule can cause delays with my benefits.
- I understand that I must call or log onto https://gibill.va.gov/wave/index.do (W.A.V.E.) to verify my attendance each month in order to get my payments from the Department of Veterans Affairs. (Applies to all receiving Chapters 30, 1606, AND Chapter 35 if less than half time)
- I understand that I must submit the appropriate form(s) to the Department of Veterans Affairs in order to receive VA Educational Benefits. In most cases this can be done through the Education Benefits Application at https://www.vets.gov/education/apply/
- _ I understand that I must submit a "Certificate of Eligibility" to the LSU Eunice Veterans Affairs Office. (Applies to Chapters 30, 33, 35, 1606)
- I understand that tuition covered by a fee exemption cannot be submitted to the VA for payment. The VA will only pay for the remaining balance after an exemption has been applied. (Chapter 33)
- I understand that taking exclusively on-line or distance education classes may cause me to be ineligible for my full housing allowance and book stipend (Chapter 33).
- I understand that I must be enrolled in at least 51% of full time hours in order to receive my full benefit (Chapter 33).
- I understand that the military, veterans of the US Armed Forces, and their dependents enrolling in public postsecondary institutions shall be classified as in-state residents for tuition purposes and will qualify for resident tuition fees.
- I understand that the VA will not pay for any late registration fees, parking fees, or meal fees.
- I understand that any refund due to me because of the Post 9/11 GI Bill (Chapter 33) will be in accordance with the refund policy of LSU Eunice. I also understand that my tuition and fees are submitted to the VA after many forms of financial aid and this can cause the payments to come later than loans or grants. Furthermore, once the school receives the payment from the VA it can take some time to be applied to my account.
